Council Tax Exemption application for an unoccupied property owned by a charity





You may get an exemption (which means you don't have to pay council tax) for a property if it:

- Is unoccupied and has been for less than 6 months
- Is owned by a charity or charitable organisation, and
- Was last used for the purpose of a charity or charitable organisation

You must tell us within 21 days of any changes that could affect the exemption, for example if the property becomes occupied.
