TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL DEVELOPMENT ORDERS 1975 AND 1974

WHEREAS

- (1) The Maidstone Borough Council (hersinafter referred to as "the Borough Council") is the District Planning Authority for the said Borough for the purposes of Section 1 of the Town and Country Planning Act, 1971, as amended by Section 182 of the Local Government Act 1972.
- (2) The Borough Council is satisfied that it is expedient in the interests of the amenities of the area that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be undertaken on Lend between Bow Bridge and Teston Bridge and situate in the Parish of Teston in the County of Kent being Parcel Number 0094 on the Ordnance Survey Map (1961 Edition) Sheets Ty/6952, and 7052 for the said County such land being shown edged red on the plan assessed hereto (hereinafter referred to as "the red land") unless permission therefor is granted on an application in that behalf.

NOW THEREFORE the Borough Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order, 1973, and of all other powers enabling it in that behalf HERESY DIRECTS that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order of 1973 shall not apply to development of the description specified in the Schedule hereto in on over or under the red land or any part or parts thereof.

TRIS DIRECTION may be cited as The Maidstone Borough Council Town and Country Planning Direction No.4 1975.

SCHEDULE

Development comprised within the undermentioned Glasses of Schedule I to the Town and Country Flamming General Development Order, 1973

Class II (1)

The erection or construction of gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure not exceeding one metro in height where abutting on a highway used by vehicular traffic or two metres in height in any other case, and the maintenance, improvement or other alteration of any gates, fences, walls or other means of enclosure:

Clase IV (2)

The use of land (other than a building or the curtilage of a building) for any purpose or purposes except as a caravan site on not more than 28 days in total in any calendar year (of which not more than 14 days in total may be devoted to use for the purpose of motor car or motor-cycle racing or for the purpose of the holding of markets) and the erection or placing of movemble structures on the land for the purposes of that use.

Class XXII (part)

The use of land, other than a building, as a caravan site in any of. the circumstances specified in paragraphs 2 and 7 of Echedule I to the Caravan Sites and Control of Development Act, 1960:

and not being development comprised within any other Class.


