DIRECTION UNDER ARTICLE 4

WHEREAS the Council of the Borough of Maidstone is satisfied that it is expedient that development of the description set out in the Schedule hereto should not be carried out on the land shown edged red on the plan annexed hereto being land at Runnings Wood, South~~lees~~ ~~Leas~~ Lane, South Green, Stockbury, Kent unless permission therefor is granted upon application made under the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988

NOW THEREFORE the said Council in pursuance of the powers conferred upon it by Article 4 of the Town and Country Planning General Development Order 1988 hereby directs that the permission granted by Article 3 of the said Order shall not apply to development on the said land of the descriptions set out in the Schedule hereto

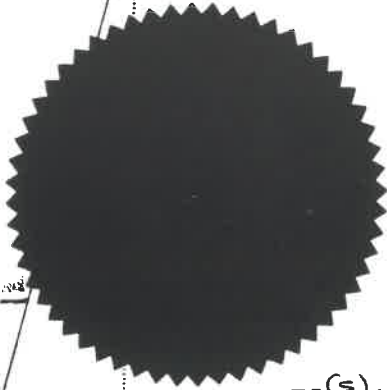
CLASS A

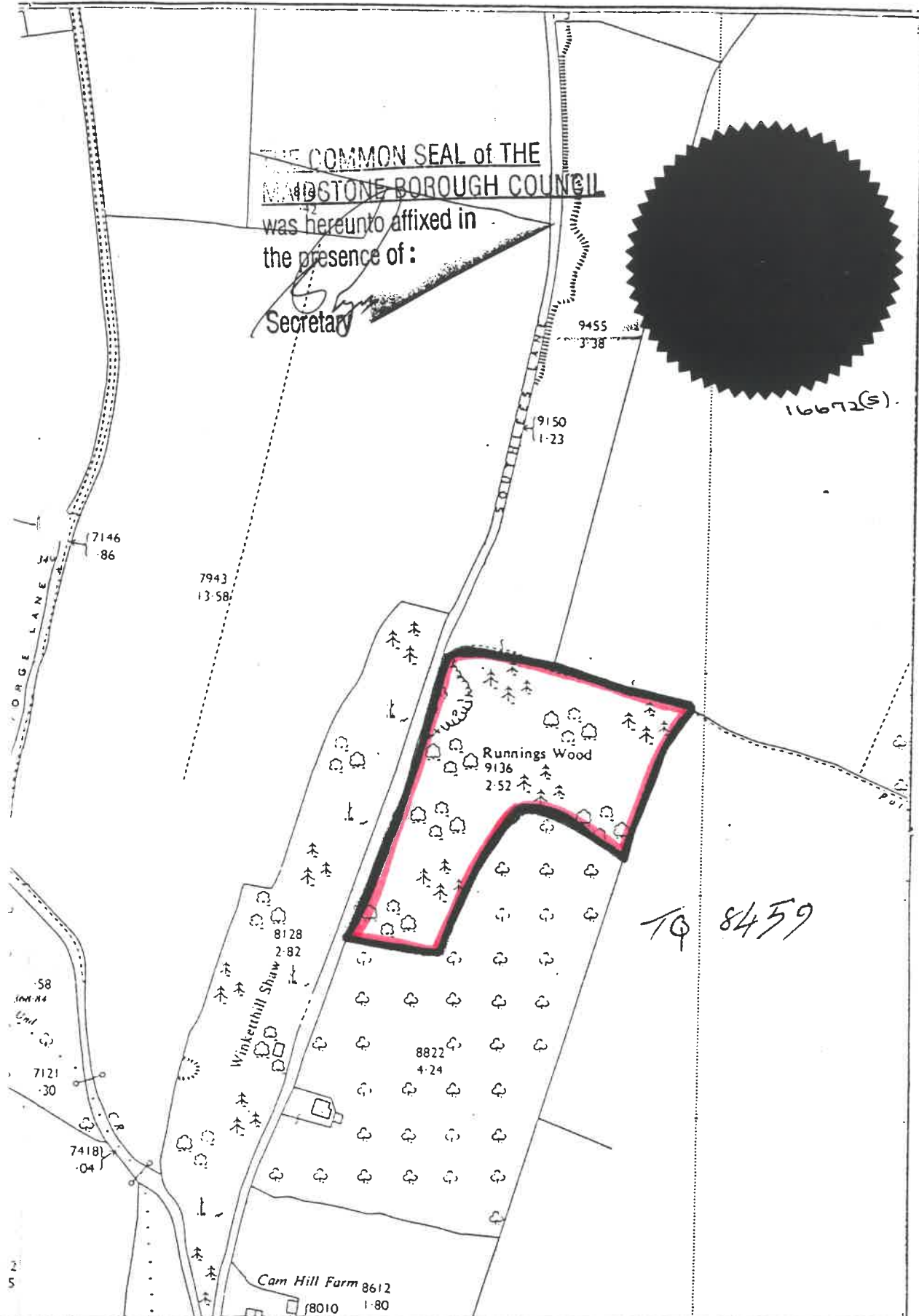

PART 6

AGRICULTURAL BUILDINGS AND OPERATIONS

CLASS A

A. The carrying out on agricultural land comprised in an agricultural unit of -

(a) works for the ~~excavation~~^{erection}, extension or alteration of a building, or

(b) any excavation or engineering operation

reasonably necessary for the purposes of agriculture within that unit.

CLASS B

B. The winning and working on land held or occupied with land used for the purposes of agriculture of any minerals reasonably necessary for agricultural purposes within the agricultural unit of which it forms part.

CLASS C

C. The carrying out on agricultural land used for the purposes of any registered business of fish farming or of shell fish farming of -

(a) operations for the construction of fish ponds, or

(b) other engineering operations for the purposes of that business.
