



Notice of Seizure of Property

The Control of Waste (dealing with seized property) (England and Wales) Regulations 2015.

Notice is hereby given that:

Maidstone Borough Council, Maidstone House, King Street, Maidstone, Kent ME15 6JQ have seized the below:

Grounds for Seizure:

- Section 5 Control of Pollution (Amendment) Act 1989 (Transporting waste without registration)
- Section 33/34/34B Environmental Protection Act 1990 (Breach of Duty of Care / Illegal depositing of waste)

Reason for Seizure:

Vehicle was seen fly tipping on 5th January and 5th February, (contrary to Section 33 EPA 1990) and was stopped carrying waste in Essex with no waste transfer notes and no waste carriers licence, (contrary to Sec 5 Control of Pollution (Amendment Act 1989)

Vehicle was seized under Section 34B EPA 1990)

To claim entitlement of seized property, contact WasteCrime@maidstone.gov.uk

Claim Period:

Any claim for the seized property must be made within **15 working days** from date of this notice

The following documents are required for a valid claim of entitlement:

- Valid photo Driving Licence / Passport.
- Two official documents showing the claimants name and address no more than three months old
- Vehicle Registration Document V5C.
- Valid certificate of motor insurance .

A seizure authority may sell, destroy, or otherwise dispose of seized property where a seizure notice has been published and:

- a) The claim period has ended and no claim was made
- b) A claim was made within the claim period, but the seizure authority did not determine that the claimant was entitled; or
- c) A duty to return arose but has ceased in accordance with regulations

If we are satisfied that entitlement to the vehicle has been established, you will have 10 days to collect it. If the vehicle is not collected within 10 working days, Maidstone Borough Council can sell or destroy it.
